Activ8 Code of Conduct

Parents/Guardians, please review this with your child(ren):

CSU Activ8 is a learning community engaged in interesting and challenging classes and camps that encourage creativity, develop talents and skills, and support the overall health of each participant. All students, regardless of disability/challenge (e.g. physical, learning, psychological, emotional, behavioral, etc.) or medical condition, must abide by the rules and regulations of the Activ8 Code of Conduct, including exhibiting classroom behavior that allows for a student environment free from harassment, discrimination, and disruption.

In order to provide students with a safe and supportive environment, we do not tolerate any form of physical or verbal abuse, harassment, vandalism, or the use of any illegal substances. Bullying, cursing, name-calling or behavior deemed unsafe by camp staff compromises the experience for everyone. This behavior will not be tolerated. Parents or guardians will be notified if campers exhibit these negative behaviors. If immediate improvement in behavior is not evident, the camper will be dismissed from camp without refund. Dangerous behavior, such as fighting, is grounds for immediate dismissal.
